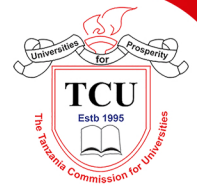

## CALL FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST TO BE REVIEWERS FOR ACADEMIC PROGRAMMES AND INSTITUTIONAL AUDITS

### 1.0 Background

The Tanzania Commission for Universities (TCU) invites qualified academic staff to serve as peer reviewers for academic programmes and institutional audits.

### 2.0 Eligibility Criteria

The applicant must:

- a) Be current or former academic staff at a university institution in Tanzania.
- b) Hold a PhD in a relevant field.
- c) Be at the rank of Senior Lecturer or above, lecturers who have not remained at the same rank for more than four (4) years may also apply.
- d) Demonstrable experience in:
  - i) Programme design, development, and review;
  - ii) Institutional audits or assessments; and
  - iii) Higher education quality assurance systems.

### 3.0 Key Responsibilities

Selected experts will:

- a) Review academic programmes for accreditation;
- b) Participate in institutional audits and evaluations;
- c) Assess teaching facilities, staffing, and learning resources;
- d) Review institutional self-assessment reports;
- e) Prepare technical reports to support decision-making; and
- f) Perform any other commissioned activities.

### 4.0 Application Process

Interested candidates should submit:

- a) A signed application letter;
- b) A one-page Expression of Interest (Eoi) detailing how they meet the stated criteria; and
- c) A Curriculum Vitae (CV).
