VERIFICATION FOR STUDIES ABROAD

How to Apply for a No Objection Certificate (NOC)

A No Objection Certificate (NOC) issued to Tanzanian citizens, provides assurance that an overseas university and its programme are recognised and accredited in the country of origin, and that the qualification is eligible for academic recognition in Tanzania. However, it does not guarantee recognition by professional regulatory bodies, which may have additional requirements for professional registration or practice. Prospective students must seek advises from the relevant professional registration bodies before commencing studies abroad.



1.0 How to Apply for a NOC

- a) Applications are submitted through online system available at <https://nocs.tcu.go.tz>, or through www.tcu.go.tz by selecting e-Services and then *No Objection Certificate for Studies Abroad*.
- b) After successful account creation, applicants will be redirected to the login page and advised to check their email inbox for account verification instructions.
- c) Payment for the application is made online during the account creation process.

2.0 Important Information and Required Documents

- a) Personal details and contacts
- b) Details of the university and admission particulars
- c) Education history from secondary education certificate to tertiary level
- d) Study mode and duration (ie. face to face, online or blended)
- e) Passport travel document number
- f) Academic certificates and transcripts
- g) Admission letter from the foreign institution
- h) Passport size photograph

3.0 How to Obtain Feedback of the Evaluation

- a) Click the "status", a message on top of your passport size photograph will display
- b) The message reads "*Click here to view and download the outcome of your evaluation*"
- c) Click the message to download the evaluation letter
- d) Print or save a pdf copy of the evaluation letter to serve your purpose
