1.0 Utangulizi

Tume ya Vyuo Vikuu Tanzania (TCU) inapenda kutoa taarifa kwa Umma, Taasisi za Elimu ya Juu na Wadau wote wa Elimu ya juu kwamba maombi ya kujiunga na vyuo vikuu hapa nchini kwa Shahada ya Kwanza yataanza rasmi tarehe 15/07/2019.

Ili kuhakikisha kuwa waombaji wa udahili wanapata taarifa sahihi na kwa wakati, Tume imeendelea kutoa elimu kwa umma kwa njia mbalimbali. Katika kipindi cha mwezi Juni na Julai, 2019 Tume imefanikiwa kutembelea Kambi zote za Jeshi la Kujenga Taifa na kutoa elimu kwa vijana waliohitimu kidato cha sita wanaoshiriki mafunzo ya JKT kwa mujibu wa Sheria. Aidha Tume kwa kushirikiana na Wizara ya Elimu na Mafunzo ya Amali iliandaa na kuendesha programu maalum ya elimu kwa umma kuhusu taratibu za udahili miini Unquia na Pemba.

2.0 Utaratibu wa Maombi ya Udahili kwa Mwaka wa Masomo 2019/20

2.1 Makundi ya Waombaji
